### 3.1 Configuration Parameters

It is the responsibility of each Party Chief to ensure that the appropriate parameters are configured properly in the instrument before running levels. In general, with the exception of one parameter in the CONFIG submenu ( INP / D ), there will be little reason to change a parameter once set properly. Instructions on how to change parameters using the SET button are in the Leica NA3003 User Manual.
