She trained in neuro-linguistic programming (NLP) and investigated several alternative therapies including reiki, shiatsu, Aura-Soma, The Demartini Method, macrobiotics, do-in, aromatherapy, reflexology, hypnotherapy, Time Line Therapy, The Journey, and The Work of Byron Katie, which all gave her a better and holistic understanding of the human being that we all are. In 2008 Gabriella joined a group of people going to Antarctica to face their fears and limiting beliefs - to test herself and put into action first hand and in a dramatic way what she learnt, and then pass it on to others.
