Teaching and learning mathematics is a political act in which children, teachers, parents, and policy makers are made

visible as subjects. As they learn about mathematics, children are also learning about themselves – who they are, who they might become. We can choose to listen or not to what children have to say about learning mathematics. Such choices constitute us in relations of power.
